ELTU credit modules for Erasmus and Study Abroad students in semester two

These modules are only open to students taking them for credits.

Please note that you must not exceed 60 credits per semester. The teaching and range of assessments for these modules continue until 5pm Friday 30 March 2012. Attendance at all classes and tests is mandatory.

EL1001 and EL1003 Study Speaking and Writing (20 credits)

Class times: The course consists of a separate 90 minute speaking class and 90 minute writing class every week. Classes take place every Wednesday afternoon. Students will be placed in a speaking class (2-3.30pm) and a writing class (3.30-5pm)

- All students who register to take **EL1001 English Speaking and Writing Skills** must do a class placement writing test the week beginning Mon 30 Jan.
- The first speaking and writing lessons will be on Wednesday 1 February from **2-5pm** in the ELTU, Readson House.

EL1002 and EL1004 Speaking and Writing (20 credits)

These modules are a continuation of EL1001 and EL 1003. They can therefore **only be taken in semester two by students who have done EL1001 or EL 1003**. There is no class placement writing test. Students who did EL1001 will automatically be placed in EL1002 and EL1003 students will be automatically placed in the EL1004 speaking class, and writing class.
