

Guidance for applicants 2012-13

1. Please check the eligibility criteria at: <http://www.le.ac.uk/international/future/open.html>
2. Application deadlines are:
 - 30 April 2012 for undergraduate applicants
 - 31 May 2012 for postgraduate applicants
3. Please note that annual tuition fees range from £8,445 -£23,645 according to your degree programme. You should allow a minimum of £650 per month for living expenses, including accommodation. All our scholarships offer only **partial** funding for your studies. If you are awarded a scholarship you will need to pay the balance of your tuition fees and living expenses.
4. Make sure that you answer all the questions on the application form. Please type or write clearly in black ink. You must sign the form personally (not third party or agent).
5. Ensure that you have included all of the following documents along with your completed application form:
 - i. Copies of your transcript(s) from your previous programmes of study (school leaving qualifications and any university-level programmes if applicable). This should be in English.
 - ii. A personal statement (typed if possible) of a maximum of 400 words, detailing academic performance, the ranking of any University that you have attended, and your personal ranking compared with other students in your class

Please do not include any other documents with your application. If we require any further information we will contact you.
