A new version of Senate Regulation 5 (SR5) has been introduced for undergraduate students beginning their studies in 2018/9. This guidance will summarise the main changes to the UG Panel and Board reports resulting from the new regulations.

Panel Reports

Input Controls

New Input Controls have been added to the Panel Report to allow the report to be filtered by Occurrence (which is reflective of the Senate Regulations a student is registered to), or simply by the SR5 Year.

Classification Frequency

To reflect the new mark boundaries in SR5 to two decimal places, the Classification Frequency chart has been separated out into separate tabs relating to the Senate Regulations year.

Non-Attempt of Assessment

Modules where a student has not completed all the required assessments are highlighted in yellow on the Panel report. This is to flag modules to the Panel to be considered in line with the regulation above.

Board Reports

Senate Regulation 5

The implementation of SR5 18/9 differs from recent regulation changes in that we will be operating two sets of regulations concurrently for different cohorts of students.

To account for multiple Senate Regulations, UG BoE Reports are now SR5 specific.

Senate Regulation 5 in place for 2017/18 for students who commenced their studies before 2018/19

Senate Regulation 5 for students commencing their studies in 2018/19 or later.

Level

Previously the report tabs were separated by level, intended award and finalist/non-finalist. The introduction of UG Interim Awards in 2017/8 resulted in all students receiving an Interim Award defined as a finalist.

As students at all levels can now receive an award, the tab splits have been simplified to Level only allowing students to be viewed with their cohort.

Interim Awards

As UG Interim Awards (CertHE & DipHE) are unclassified, they were not differentiated on the UG BoE Reports and both displayed a classification of "PASS".

Interim Awards will now display in the 'Calc Class' column as CertHE or DipHE.

Compensated Fails

Compensated Fails are highlighted on BoE Report UG SR5 18/9 in the same way as Pass for Credit is on BoE Report UG SR5 17/8.
